National Fallen Firefighters Foundation Honors Cy-Fair Fire Department with 2025 Seal of Excellence Award

Houston, TX – October 24, 2025 – The National Fallen Firefighters Foundation (NFFF) will present its prestigious Ronald Siarnicki Seal of Excellence Award to the Cy-Fair Fire Department (CFFD) in recognition of its exceptional commitment to firefighter safety, health, and wellness. The award presentation will take place at the CFFD Administration Office, 10710 Telge Road, Houston, Texas.

The Seal of Excellence is awarded to departments that demonstrate outstanding leadership in reducing firefighter line-of-duty deaths and injuries. CFFD has set a benchmark for the fire service nationwide through its innovative programs, operational excellence, and cultural commitment to safety.

Highlights of CFFD's safety and wellness initiatives include:

- **Mental Health & Wellness** – Implementation and growth of the THRIVE! program and Peer Support Network, along with annual FrontLine health and wellness screenings for all personnel.
- **Safety Stand Down Leadership** – Consistent participation in national campaigns promoting firefighter health and injury prevention.
- **Active Shooter Preparedness** – Integrated training with schools and law enforcement, adopting the ALERRT Active Attack Integrated Response concept.
- **Comprehensive Training Division** – Ranked among the top five largest department-based training divisions in Texas, with all instructors credentialed and professional development integrated into department operations.
- **Safety-First Culture** – Emphasizing teamwork, accountability, and empowering firefighters to stop unsafe practices during training, operations, and on-scene response.

“Cy-Fair Fire Department’s transformation from an all-volunteer agency into one of Texas’ largest combination departments is remarkable,” said Victor Stagnaro, CEO of the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation. “What makes their journey extraordinary is their unwavering dedication to safety, wellness, and innovation while serving a rapidly growing community of more than 600,000 residents. Their work embodies the very spirit of the Seal of Excellence.”
